Dr. Elisa M. Benes is Senior Statistician in the Standards and Methods Unit, Statistics Department of the International Labor Office in Geneva. Prior to joining the ILO, she worked as a statistician at the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe, in Geneva, and at the United Nations Statistics Division, in New York, supporting international and regional programmes on social and demographic statistics. She has also extensive experience in household surveys, having worked for several years as a technical advisor, survey manager and field supervisor in several countries around the world. At the ILO, she was responsible for the review and update of the international standards on statistics of work, employment and labour underutilization recently adopted by the 19th International Conference of Labour Statisticians (ICLS) in 2013 and is currently involved in the Department's activities to disseminate and promote the implementation of the new statistical standards through labour force surveys. She holds a PhD in Demography and Sociology from Brown University, United States of America and a certificate on survey sampling from the University of Michigan, Unites States of America. Elisa M.
